**Driver Instructions for Granite Springs Field
Trips**

When using your private vehicle to transport students on field trips or other school activity trips, please certify that:

1. You possess a current valid driver's license.
2. You affirm that you currently do not have two (2) or more points (including any offenses) assigned by DMV to your driving record.
3. You have completed Granite Springs' Parent Automobile Transportation Form and certify that you carry at least \$100,000 per occurrence worth of liability insurance on your vehicle.
4. You will check the safety of your vehicle: tires, brakes, lights, horn, suspension, etc., before you embark on the trip.
5. You will carry only the number of passengers for which your vehicle was designed and not in any case exceed ten. (More than nine passengers and the driver, a total of ten occupants, in any vehicle constitutes a school bus and requires a special license.)
6. If your vehicle is a truck or pick-up, occupants shall only be carried in the passenger compartment.
7. You will require all occupants to wear a safety belt.
8. In case of an emergency, you will keep all of the children together, call 911 first and then call the church and/or designated person.

I certify that I have not been convicted of reckless driving or driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol within the past five years and that the information given above is true and correct. If requested, I would submit to a drug test. I understand that if an accident occurs, my private insurance coverage shall bear primary responsibility for any losses or claims for damages. I hereby waive all claims against Granite Springs for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during, or by reason of, this field trip or excursion.
